Sometimes the court system can be frustrating. The system moves very slow and it is by far not a perfect system. Cases generally last anywhere from one year to multiple years and sometimes until a child ages out (at 18). In order to provide stability for these children we ask CASA volunteers to stay on the case as long as possible, ideally for the entire length of the case.
