

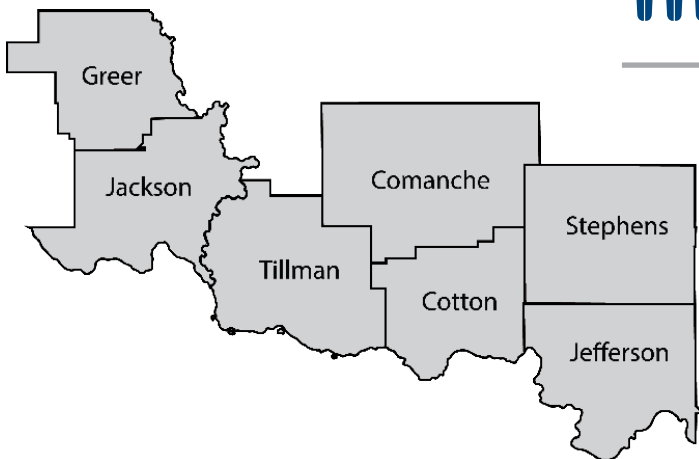

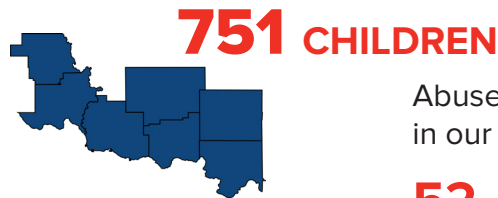
WHAT IS A CASA VOLUNTEER?

- ✂ A Court Appointed Special Advocate (CASA) is a community volunteer that offers a consistent presence in a child's life during their time in foster care.
- ✂ CASA volunteers provide valuable information to the judge and others involved in the case to help ensure a child's best interest is being met.
- ✂ CASA volunteers come from different backgrounds, neighborhoods and communities just like the kids they help.
- ✂ **CASA volunteers help ensure a child's voice is heard.**

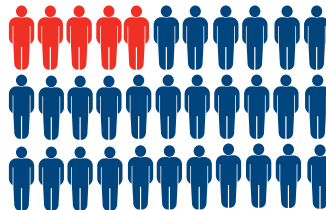

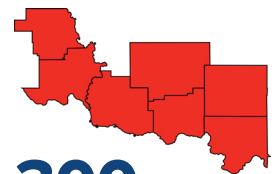
Abused and neglected children in our community. ^{*(FY23, OKDHS)}

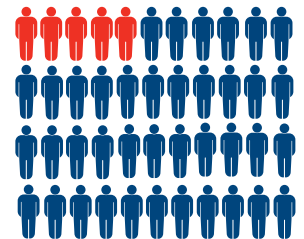
